We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen

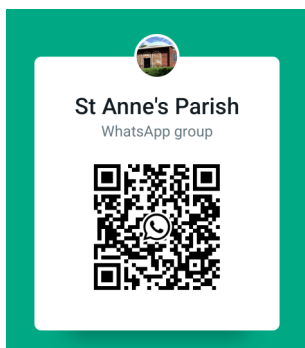
INFORMACJE DLA POLAKÓW

III NIEDZIELA WIELKANOCNA

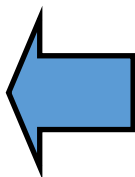
1. W dzisiejszą niedzielę obchodzimy III Niedzielę Wielkanocną.
2. Kancelaria w j. polskim w tym tygodniu jest czynna w czwartek od 16.00 do 17.00.
3. W czwartek od 17.30 do 18.30 wystawienie i adoracja Najświętszego Sakramentu.
4. W piątek 9 maja spotkanie dla dzieci przygotowujących się do Pierwszej Komunii św.
5. **LOTERIA PARAFIALNA** Chcemy ponownie uruchomić Loterię, którą Kath Parry prowadziła przez wiele lat. Zapisy rozpoczną się 4 maja, a format będzie następujący: £1 GBP tygodniowo, z 1 losowaniem miesięcznie. Wybrana liczba zostanie wybrana przez osobę wybierającą losowo numery.
