While there are no specific reference to churches in the latest Welsh Government update, it is to be presumed that face coverings are no longer mandatory but of course those wishing to wear a mask are free to do so.

THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION IS BEING RESTORED IN ENGLAND AND WALES THIS PENTECOST.

Although the obligation was suspended at the start of the pandemic, the Bishops have concluded that since many people have resumed normal life - seeing friends, going shopping, eating out, and generally mixing socially - it is reasonable to resume the obligation.

As has always been the case, those who are unable to attend Mass for serious reasons - for example because of illness, care for the sick, or legitimate fear - are not required to go to Mass.

When we go to Mass, we are present at Calvary. We are witnesses to Jesus' death. What's more, we are present with Jesus Himself, and we are able to worship together as a community.

Rather than seeing the obligation as a duty or a chore, see Mass as an intimate encounter with Jesus. Just as the pandemic taught many of us that video calls with family we were kept apart from was no substitute for seeing our loved ones in person, likewise live-streaming is not comparable to being in the physical presence of Our Lord and Saviour.

The obligation will come back into place on Pentecost, Sunday 5th June for Catholics in England and Wales.
