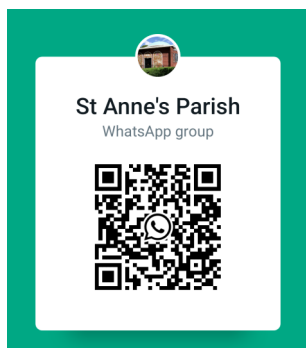

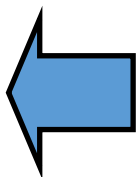
1. W dzisiejszą niedzielę obchodzimy XIV Niedzielę Zwykłą w ciągu roku liturgicznego.
