RESTORING HOLY COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS

After an absence of over two years, we will soon be able to start offering again the opportunity to receive the Precious Blood from the Chalice during Mass. The Church teaches that Holy Communion ‘has a fuller sign when it takes place under both kinds, for in this form, the sign of the Eucharistic banquet is more clearly evident.’ Put simply, Jesus said ‘take and eat, take and drink...’ It will be each individual’s choice whether they receive from the Chalice or not, but we will begin offering it at every Mass in the parish, starting on the solemnity of The Most Holy Body & Blood of the Lord (11th June) There is a leaflet available at the back of Church and on our website, outlining the meaning of Eucharist, our celebration of Mass, and giving some context to this re-introduction of the Chalice.

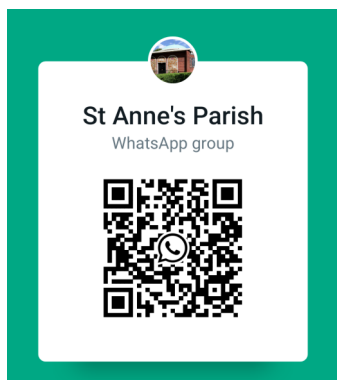
